- From 2017-18 academic year, board exams are mandatory for class 10 students. Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has also remodeled the assessment pattern for class 10 students. Refer ( Circular No. Acad-05/2017).
- Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is implementing Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report card for Class VI-IX from Academic year 2017-2018 onwards. Refer (Circular No. : Acad-14/2017) and our school adheres to the same. A detailed information will be provided to you in the Academic Plan for the same.
- According to CBSE and other administrative needs AADHAR CARD is Mandatory for all school students. Every parent is requested to procure the card for your ward at the earliest.
- Code of Conduct - Our School Almanac gives Code of Conduct about appropriate student behavior, as well as procedures for disciplinary action. The Code is designed to emphasize the importance of creating safe, welcoming school environments that support student learning. CBSE has also re-emphasized the DISCIPLINE aspect for students, refer (CBSE Circular No.Acad-14/2017). There are grades allotted for student discipline in the report card itself. So it is important that discipline of your ward should be up to the mark. He/She is also expected to display punctuality and appropriate human values.
