Libraries are only next in importance to schools, colleges and universities as means of educating the public. A library is a store-house of books-books of all kinds and on all subjects under the sun.







Top 10 Libraries of the World

1.Library of Congress

Library of Congress, Washington DC, is known as one of the biggest libraries in US. It stocks 30,000,000 books in many languages and many disciplines. It was built in 1800 and the building itself is beautifully designed. It was featured in National Treasure 2 Movie.

2. National Library of China

Situated in Beijing National Library of China is one of the renowned icons of the city. It stocks 22 million books and it was built in 1909. You can find many things here.

3.Library of the Russian Academy of Sciences

It is located in the heart of St. Petersburg City and it has stocked millions of books since 1714 when the library was built. Today it collects more than 20 million books in thousands of disciplines.

4. National Library of Canada

National Library of Canada is famous for its modern construction and easy-to-access location. It is located in Ottawa city of Canada and it was built in 1953. The number of books available in this library are 18,800,000 collections

5.German National Library

German National Library is a government property and it is located in the capital of Frankfurt. The library has been standing in the area since 1990 and it stocks 18,500,000 books, so far.

6.British Library

British Library is one of the oldest buildings in London. The library was built in 1753 and it stocks a collection of 16,000,000 books in literature.

7. Institute for Scientific Information Russian Academy of Sciences

The library was built in 1969 and it is situated in the centre of Russia's capital city, Moscow. It stocks 13,500,000 books and not all of the books are about Scientific Information in Russian Language.

8. Harvard University Library

Harvard University Library is one of the proudest buildings in Harvard University and has been supplying lot of information and new knowledge to Harvard's students since 1638. The library is located in Cambridge, MA, US and it stocks a collection of 13,100,000 books.

9. Vernadsky National Library of Ukrain

The library is located in Kieve, Ukrain. Vernadsky National Scientific Library of Ukrain was built in 1919 and since that time, the library has stocked millions of books from around the world. Today 13,000,000 books are stocked in the building.

10.New York Public Library

The New York Public Library is situated in New York City and it was built in 1895. At this time, the library stocks around 11,000,000 books.
